
Re: Investigation of President Trump, post Mueller Report

Dear Congressman Kilmer,

Now that the Mueller Report has been released, my colleagues and I believe that there is adequate cause to be concerned about the cases of obstruction of justice demonstrated by President Trump, and the dangers his actions bring to the rule of law, the sanctity of our electoral process and our democracy. As Congress deliberates on what to do, we respectfully assert that we are indeed not living in normal times with our institutions under harsh and unrelenting attack by the sitting Commander in Chief. We therefore ask that the House of Representatives use its full powers granted under the Constitution to pursue a thorough investigation of the President. Such an investigation needs to be done in a careful and deliberate manner, with no rush to judgement. All possible courses of action must however be kept on the table. This of course includes impeachment.

We thank you for your consideration to this matter, as we urge your strong and steadfast leadership. Please be advised that we are writing to you as individual Councilmembers for the City of Bainbridge and are not representing the full Council.
