

Wyatt Way Reconstruction



Overview

The Wyatt Way Reconstruction project will improve safety for people walking, rolling, bicycling or driving by constructing a “complete street” with sidewalks and bike lanes on Wyatt Way between Madison Avenue and Lovell Avenue.


The levels of service and connections for all users will be maintained and improved, and poor pavement and drainage features will be replaced. The project also includes the replacement of older sections of a water main.



Key Features

At the intersection:


- A mini roundabout to improve traffic flow and safety for people walking. School buses, fire trucks and other truck traffic will be able to safely travel through the roundabout
- Widened, multi-use sidewalks with ramp access for bicycles
- Improved ADA crosswalks and ramps
- Large trees on Wyatt Way, just west of Madison Avenue, will be preserved.



Key Features

Along Wyatt Way (between Madison Ave & Lovell Ave):

- Construction of a sidewalk on the north and south sides of Wyatt Way (currently, no sidewalk exists)
- 5-foot-wide paved bicycle lanes on both sides of Wyatt Way
- Water main and storm drainage systems improvements
- Lighting, landscaping and stormwater quality improvements



Project Costs

The project is funded by several sources:

State Transportation Improvement Board Grant =	\$2,516,000
City of Bainbridge Island General Fund =	\$1,492,351
City of Bainbridge Island Water Utility =	\$322,500
Project total =	\$4,330,851

What's Next?

- Construction is expected to begin the week of June 15 and last through fall 2020
- People walking, bicycling and driving can expect detours in and around the project area
