

#B008 RESIDENTIAL STAIR DETAILS

When Is A Permit Required?

To protect people from falling and possibly injuring themselves, there are specific code requirements regarding the height of a step and when a handrail is required.

A permit required for stairways with 4 or more risers. International Residential Code (IRC) Section R311.7 details stair construction requirements and should be followed regardless if a permit is required or not.

Refer to the figure below for a summary of applicable code requirements.

What Else Should I Know?

- Consult the Planning Division at Bainbridge Island City Hall to confirm your setbacks or other zoning regulations related to shorelines or critical areas. Shoreline Development
- All development within 200' of ordinary high water requires the submittal of a Shoreline Substantial Development Exemption prior to the submission of a building permit.

STANDARD CONSTRUCTION DETAILS

Required stairway width = 36"

Required Nose = $\frac{3}{4}$ " – 1 $\frac{1}{4}$ " Note: Nosing not required if tread depth is greater than 11".
